Koinonia – translated from Greek in the New Testament to denote “fellowship” or “sharing.” Also can be described as “communion by intimate participation” and “contribution.”

It is a word used to describe the relationship within the early church as well as the communion with Christ and the act of “breaking bread” as during the Passover meal. It is the basis of bonding in fellowship with the faithful.
